Purpose of the Policy

Data Collection and Use

Types of Data Collected

- Personal information (e.g., name, address, contact details)
- Academic records
- Health information (where applicable)

Purpose of Data Processing

- To provide personalised education and support
- To monitor student progress and wellbeing
- To comply with legal obligations and safeguarding requirements

Data Storage and Security

Data Storage

- Personal data will be stored securely in accordance with data protection regulations.
- Access to personal data will be restricted to authorised personnel only.

Data Security Measures

- Use of encryption and secure servers
- Regular audits and assessments of data security practices

Data Sharing and Disclosure

Internal Sharing

• Personal data may be shared internally among staff for educational purposes.

External Sharing

• Personal data will not be shared with third parties without consent, except where required by law (e.g., safeguarding).
